Finans-Subkomitee

Geagte lede van Oakdale Klub

Wat kan ons noem van die finansiële stand van die Klub, behalwe dat die veranderings aan die kroeg en die dobbelmasjiene ons kontantvloei heeltemal verander het. Waar ons 'n paar weke gelede nie geweet het waar die kontant vandaan gaan kom om die kroeg-aanbouing te betaal, sit ons nou met 'n positiewe kontantvloei waar ons nou stelselmatig kan begin delg aan ons lenings.

Die goeie nuus is, dat geen lenings aangegaan is om die rokerskroeg te voltooi nie. Die totale beraamde koste van R148 000 vir die verandering het geëindig op R167 000 insluitende btw. Variasies wat 'n wesenlike impak op kostes gehad het, is die glaspaneel tussen die ou en nuwe areas, addisionele krag en TV punte, kroegdiens deur en venster bygevoeg. Die kroegtoonbank projek se beraambe koste was R40 000 en het geëindig op R36 000.

Baie dankie vir julle belangstelling en donasies aan Oakdale Klub, waarsonder dit ons taak moeiliker sou gemaak het vir die spoedige afhandeling van die kroeg. Ons kan ook al ons rokers bedank vir hul geduld tydens die afwagting van die nuwe fasiliteit.

Voorraadkontroleringsprosesse word verfyn, sowel as daaglikse kontantvloeiprojeksies wat op datum gehou word. Johan is besig met krediteure, debiteure en voorraadkontroleringsprosesse en die daarstelling daarvan, sowel as opleiding wat gegee word aan Rudi en Stadler.

'n Spesiale versoek aan ons lede: Ons het geen probleem as ons lede van 'n kroegrekening gebruik maak nie met die voorbehoud dat die rekening aan die einde van die aand betaal word. Indien die rekening nie betaal word nie word 'n groot administratiewe las op die personeel geplaas om die geld in te vorder. 'n Administratiewe fooi van R50 sal voortaan verhaal word indien die rekening nie op dieselfde dag vereffen is nie. Geen verdere krediete sal toegestaan word voor die rekening nie vereffen is nie.

Aan al ons lede, baie dankie vir julle ondersteuning tydens die verbreking en daarstelling van die nuwe kroeg.

Sien julle hopelik gouer as later by die Klub.
